

### MEN AND RESPONSIBILITY

Opening comment. The war is against Godly self-controled men; the necessarey foundation for a godly nation

THE PREACHER'S WARNING

25 I applied mine heart to know, and to search, and to seek out wisdom, and the reason [of things], and to know the wickedness of folly, even of foolishness [and] madness: 26 And I find more bitter than death the woman, whose heart [is] snares and nets, [and] her hands [as] bands: whoso pleaseth God shall escape from her; but the sinner shall be taken by her. Ecclesiastes 7.

He had 1000 women, for the kingdoms around him sent women to him in order to be connected to the richest and wisest man ever to live. He speaks from his experiences that we should learn from.

The Preacher tells us of a woman who caught a man. because that man's heart was not stayed upon the Lord. (Pro 2:16-19, 3:3, 22:14) On the other hand, the man who pleases God with his actions and thoughts is delivered by the grace of God from the lust of the flesh – in this case, the woman who set a snare for him. In v. 26, the Preacher tells us why women are gaining such tremendous control and

authority over men in every area of life:

family, church, social, occupational, civil, &c. Because their heart is not stayed on the Lord, pornography is snaring multitudes of men making them useless in the Kingdom. The law tells us that the lack of self-control among men especially has devastating consequences

**Exodus 22:16** And if a man entice a maid that is not betrothed, and lie with her, he shall surely endow her to be his wife. 17 If her father utterly refuse to give her unto him, he shall pay money according to the dowry of virgins. Deuteronomy 22:28 If a man find a damsel [that is] a virgin, which is not betrothed, and lay hold on her, and lie with her, and they be found; 29 Then the man that lay with her shall give unto the damsel's father fifty [shekels] of silver, and she shall be his wife; because he hath humbled her, he may not put her away all his days.

The law established that a man who seduced a single woman before marriage had to pay her father 50 shekels of silver, about three years wages, and, if permitted by the girl's father, he was to marry the girl he seduced. Moreover, the man who seduced the woman could never put her away for the rest of his life.

Thus, the heinous sin committed by the boys in Genesis 34 against Schechem. The evil was not Jacob seeking his sons' advice about the situation with their sister; the evil was that he permitted them to utterly destroy the city even though the young man wanted to do the right thing. At the very least, Jacob should have allowed the boy to pay the dowry even if Jacob refused the marriage. But the law was not written down yet.

This [the law of Exo and Deut] was an exceedingly wise and humane law, and must have operated powerfully against seduction and fornication; because the person who might feel inclined to take the advantage of a young woman knew that he must marry her, and give her a dowry, if her parents consented; and if they did not consent that their daughter should wed her seducer, in this case he was obliged to give her the full dowry which could have been demanded had she been still a virgin. According to the *Targumist* here, and to, {De 22:29} the dowry was fifty shekels of silver, which the seducer was to pay to her father, and he was obliged to take her to wife; nor had he authority, according to the Jewish canons, ever to put her away by a bill of divorce. This one consideration was a powerful curb on disorderly passions, and must tend greatly to render marriages respectable, and prevent all crimes of this nature. (Clarke. See Matt 19:8)

Exodus 22:16, 17. The seduction of a girl, who belonged to her father as long as she was not betrothed, [{cf. Ex 21:7}] was also to be regarded as an attack upon the family possession. (KD)

Upon marriage, the seduced woman was not required to submit to her husband's authority, but, obviously, she was still subject to the authority of God's law. In other words, adultery, murder, &c., on her part still required death under God's authority, but she did not have to submit to her husband's authority. She could be rebellious against her husband's authority, and he had no Godly recourse but to tolerate her rebellion, but she could not rebel against God.

Briefly stated: if the man could not control his passions before marriage, he had no legal recourse before God to control his family after marriage. If the man was a slave to his passions before marriage, then he was a slave to his wife after marriage. If the man failed to exercise proper authority before marriage, God gave the woman the authority. But obviously, he could work to exercise proper authority in his home after marriage.

One would be foolish to think women of Old Testament times did not realize the hold they could gain

over a man by seducing him before marriage. Actually, the hold was much stronger than can be gained by seduction today. For if he succumbed to her advances, no matter how overt, it cost him three years pay (dowry of a virgin). But far worse than the cost in silver, God made him a slave to his wife if her father permitted the marriage. Thus, the Preacher's warning to young men in Proverbs 2.

Only the foolish would think that the enemy of all Godliness does not realize how God's law works; thus, his effort to influence the men in society to lose authority over their own spirits. He knows what snares to use. He knows that if he can overturn a man's authority over his own spirit before marriage, he has overturned a man's proper authority in his family and in society after marriage. The enemy knows how to destroy the foundation of society; he knows, furthermore, that any effort to correct the "top" without correcting the foundation is futile. In other words, he realizes what we fail to realize: the top is overthrown from the bottom. He has overthrown and is overthrowing society through unrestrained fornication, and "living together." Pornography is intentionally kept before the eyes of the public in order to overthrow a "Christian society."

When the foundations are destroyed, the righteous must flee by faith and obedience to *the LORD who is in his holy temple*. (Ps 11)

Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.

Balaam knew that fornication would bring the LORD'S judgment upon his people, and He would do what Balac could not do.

The context of Ecclesiastes 7:26 tells us of a woman who seduces the man before marriage. It also tells that the godly man in thoughts and actions will be delivered by God's grace from the woman's seductive actions. On the other hand, the man who does not have his spirit under control will be taken snared by her.

The law is clear—the man is always responsible to be in Godly authority no matter how enticing a woman might be before marriage. The man is always held responsible and accountable though she may be the one making the advances before marriage. If he is in Godly authority over his passions, he will remain free of her clutches. If he allows his passions to gain control, he

must pay the price. And what a horrendous price to pay for a moment's pleasure. (Do we think Solomon said in vain, *To deliver thee from the strange woman...*? James 4:5)

#### **IMPLICATIONS**

First, through immorality before marriage, females are placing passionate males under their authority and control. The female is the one in authority in the relationship if the male either is seduced by her or seduces her; hence the many modern families currently controlled by the wives. An immoral relationship before marriage placed the husband under her authority after marriage, and she now may or may not lead her husband around according to her will. The husband may deny, both publicly and privately in his own heart that he yielded his godly authority to her before marriage and that he is now under her authority, but facts speak otherwise. Certainly, all our wives know how to direct things more to their liking, but here we see the woman exercising authority in the realm of worship, occupation, &c. Please note, though, that we are not saying that in all marriages in which the wife exerts ungodly authority are the result of the husband's ungodly authority before marriage.

What a wonderful promise of forgiveness and a clear conscience Paul gives us in 1 Corinthians 6:1. **Godly conversion and repentance** will result in godly authority in the home,

The breakdown of godly authority in the home started with the breakdown of godly authority when the man (or woman) might have said, "Why not? We are going to be married anyway." As a result, not only are fathers stripped of their godly authority in their families, but society in general is stripped of its proper authority. The breakdown of godly authority in the home is found in the Word of God, *i.e.*, lack of godly discipline and self-control. Men do not or cannot exercise proper authority over their spirit; they are unable or refuse to be men.

Can one gain proper control of his home? Yes! But it must begin by confession of sin and taking Godly responsibility for sin. It must start by the husband confessing to his wife: "It was my fault, not yours! It was wrong and I ask your forgiveness." This will permit the man to gain the godly control of his house. Though he may have control already without confession, can it be the loving control without confession of sin?

**Second, not only is Godly authority** lost in the home after marriage because it was lost before marriage,

Godly authority is undermined throughout society. Because the God ordained roles of authority are reversed by the man's uncontrolled passions before marriage, the woman's God-ordained role is also reversed: the woman moves into positions of society never meant for her by God. Moreover, no effort short of godly, Biblical morality before and after marriage can reverse the trend of women usurping the men's place in society.

Third, rampant crime. The "crime wave" started when the man yielded to his passions before marriage. Crime will be "brought under control" only when the men of the society bring their spirit under control. It goes without saying that the proper control comes from conversion and the control of the Spirit of God.

Conclusion: A man is responsible to be in godly authority at all times no matter what the circumstances, especially over his own passions. When the man fails in his godly responsibility of authority, the woman is given authority by God. Therefore, godly authority in the home and society must start by men exercising godly authority over their spirits, self-control. Additionally, those already in the compromised position after marrying their "lover" now must accept responsibility for all their actions with their wives before marriage if they expect to be the proper godly authority in their homes and society.

Can we expect a wife to submit to proper authority after marriage if her husband could not submit to proper authority before marriage? Ungodly actions must be repented of before the woman can be expected to or required to properly submit after marriage.

Thus, we cannot over-stress the importance of the man, no matter what kind of pressure is placed upon him by his passions being responsible and pleasing God at all times.

James 4:5 Do ye think that the scripture saith in vain, The spirit that dwelleth in us lusteth to envy? 6 But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.

## IF YOU'VE GOT IT FLAUNT IT

WITH LOWCUT TOPS AND LEGGINGS

In the early 1970s while watching a news program in Indianapolis, I heard a beautiful talking head say, "If you've Got it, Flaunt it." That phrase comes to mind every time I see a woman in leggings and or a low-cut top that shows a lot of skin. (However, a good number of

women who wear leggings have nothing to flaunt; they are embarrassing to see.)

**Flaunt it:** If you've got something you're proud of don't be afraid to show it off.

"This expression originates in the 1967 movie The Producers, written and directed by Mel Brooks. The phrase was shouted out the window by Max Bialystock (played by Zero Mostel): 'That's it, baby, when you've got it, flaunt it! Flaunt it!'"

1 Timothy 2:9 In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array;

**Definitions of Modest apparel** have been argued for years. Modest apparel can best be summed up as dressing or behaving so as to avoid impropriety or indecency, especially to avoid attracting sexual attention (typically used of a woman).

Being honest, can one consider leggings *modest apparel?* Are extremely tight-fitting jeans modest? (What is the attraction of jeans that look like they got caught in a chainsaw?)

In the last several years, leggings and revealing tops, have become standard dress for many women, even in sound, Bible preaching churches. It is not uncommon to see young women walking around in public showing as much skin as possible without being arrested for indecent exposure. Do women not realize that they are drawing sexual attention; but that may be their intention. Why do husbands let their wives and daughters dress so provocatively? Why do not husbands, fathers and the pulpit make it clear that any "red-blooded" man cannot view a well-figured woman in leggings with holy thoughts? ("It is the his fault if he looks!" What a sad justification for sexually provocative appeal. Mk 10:19, 1 Cor 6:8, 1 Thess 4:6)

When was the last time we heard a message against appeal that stirs up sexual attention and thoughts?

Acts 20:26 Wherefore I take you to record this day, that I [am] pure from the blood of all [men]. 27 For I have not shunned to declare unto you all the counsel of God. 28 Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood.

Can one preach *all the counsel of God* without addressing one of the more common and ignored sins of our

day: sexually provocative apparel that is so common now in *the house of God?*

[With] the attire of an harlot.] [{See Trapp on "Pr 6:25"}] The Hebrew word here signifies a set habit or ornament finely fitted to the body: ... And subtile of heart.] Or, Trussed up about the breasts, with her upper parts naked. Trapp

Solomon tells us that *the attire of an harlot* is the mark of an evil heart regardless of what is professed with the mouth.

Zephaniah 1:8 And it shall come to pass in the day of the LORD'S sacrifice, that I will punish the princes, and the king's children, and all such as are clothed with strange apparel.

## WLC 139: What are the sins forbidden in the Seventh Commandment?

Answer: The sins forbidden in the Seventh Commandment, besides the neglect of the duties required, are, adultery, fornication, rape, incest, sodomy, and all unnatural lusts<sub>4</sub>; all unclean imaginations, thoughts, purposes, and affections; all corrupt or filthy communications, or listening thereunto, wanton looks, impudent or light behavior, immodest apparel<sub>8</sub>; prohibiting of lawful<sub>o</sub>, and dispensing with unlawful marriages<sub>10</sub>; allowing, tolerating, keeping of stews, and resorting to them,; entangling vows of single life,, undue delay of marriage<sub>13</sub>; having more wives or husbands than one at the same time<sub>14</sub>; unjust divorce<sub>15</sub>, or desertion<sub>16</sub>; idleness, gluttony, drunkenness<sub>17</sub>, unchaste company<sub>18</sub>; lascivious songs, books, pictures, dancings, stage plays,; and all other provocations to, or acts of uncleanness, either in ourselves or others.20

<sup>8</sup> Prov. 7:10, 13, her "immodest apparel" revealed what is in her heart. The "immodest apparel" was meant to draw the attention of men, to get them to lust after outward beauty. See also Isa 47:2.

# Outward appearance always makes a statement either for the world or for the Lord whom we claim to

**love.** Does our outward language say that we have been bought with a price, and that we have been set apart

for holiness for the Lord Jesus Christ? Certainly, God sees the heart, but the truth of the heart is shown by our appearance for all to see. Appearance that draws sexual attention says anything but that we are trying be holy even as he is holy.

1 Corinthians 6:20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

Lord, remind us that we are required to

glorify Him not only in our spirit, but in our body. We need the same grace to glorify Him in our bodies as we need to glorify Him in our spirit.



# "LEARN NOT THE WAY OF THE GENTILES"

Learn not the way of the heathen (Jeremiah 10:2).

The term "heathen" in Jeremiah 10:2 literally means "gentile." The "New King James" Version correctly translates it that way. Under the Old Testament, the gospel was primarily confined to the nation of Israel. The oracles of God were committed unto them (Romans 3:2). God gave to them the scriptures, the Law, the sacrificial system and its ceremonies, the priests, and the true way of worship under that Old Covenant. The gentiles were generally excluded from the Church during that time. There was a wall of partition that kept the gentiles separated from the commonwealth of Israel which made them strangers from the covenants of promise, and generally they had no hope and were without God in the world (Ephesians 2:12-14).

The term "gentile" strictly refers to the descendents of Japheth (Genesis 9:27; 10:2-5). In its widest use it refers to all non-Hebrews. This is the way the Jews came to think of all who were not of Israel, and in the time of Christ they referred to them as "dogs", and our Lord Himself used this ethnic epithet (Matthew 15:26-27). To the Jewish mind there were but two classes of people- Jews and those who wished they were.

Under the Old Testament the Jews were to segregate themselves from the gentiles. They were not to allow their children to intermarry with them, nor were they to imitate their customs. It was the purpose of God to keep Israel separate from the heathens, primarily because He would bring in the Redeemer through them. Israel was to be a holy people and they were entrusted by God to keep the worship of Himself pure under the Old Covenant.

Now, we need to understand that when God commanded Israel to "learn not the way of the heathen," He

was talking about our ancestors! As far as we know we have no readers who are of Jewish extraction, although we do not know that absolutely because this column is emailed to many and we know some of them sometimes forward to others. As far as we know, most (if not all) of our readers are gentiles. Most of you are of European, Native American, or African descent. All of our ancestors were heathens, separated from the commonwealth of Israel and without the hope of salvation and without the gospel. As far as we know, all of our ancestors from Western and Northern Europe and Africa and the Americas who lived before the first century all died and went to hell. Now before you get mad, let me add that this is a general statement, and we do not know that absolutely, and certainly not infallibly. We do know that God saved a few Gentiles during the Old Testament era, and we also understand from the scriptures that gentiles who would believe the gospel promises and submit to the true way of worship could be admitted into the commonwealth of Israel. Most of the "proselytes" were gentiles living in and around Israel. As far as we know none of our ancestors in Western and Northern Europe, and in Africa, and in the Americas ever heard of Jehovah and His Truth. Again, we say, "as far as we know." But the fact remains that by and large most, if not all our ancestors were indeed heathens

Our ancestors worshiped false deities and practiced foul customs. They put markings on their flesh, and pierced their bodies, and burned their dead. They were licentious and filthy sexually. They ran around naked and wild. They worshiped the sun and the heavenly bodies and they had wretched "holidays" and bowed to the heavenly bodies. They worshiped and served the creation instead of the Creator (Romans 1:25). If you ever start getting lifted up too much in racial pride, you just need to read a little bit about your heathen ancestors.

Thanks be unto God it was His purpose to break down the middle wall of partition that kept us gentiles at a distance from the oracles of God! How thankful we Gentiles should be that Christ commissioned His apostles to take the gospel to the whole world. How thankful we should be that the gospel came to Northern and Western Europe and to North Africa. How thankful we should be for the discovery of the Americas and the bringing of the gospel to the benighted people who inhabited these continents. How thankful we should be for God's Providence in even using the slave trade to bring many of His elect to these shores where they

heard the saving gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ. How thankful we should be for the colonisation of Africa and India which opened the way for the evangelisation of those lands. God was and is fulfilling His promise to call out multitudes from the gentiles, and we believe He will call out many more.

Where this saving gospel has gone with power it has resulted in great changes not only in individuals, but in communities and nations. As the people of Europe came to believe in the true God it radically changed that continent. The laws and customs of the European nations began to reflect the law of God, and this was particularly true of the British Isles. The people who founded this nation generally were Christians, or at least influenced by Christianity. Western Europe and the United States for a while could be considered as "Christian" because their laws and customs to a great extent were grounded in Biblical Law.

Sadly, we see the people of the Western nations now rejecting the God of the Bible and the Lordship of His Son and returning to the heathen practices of our ancestors. The present aim of the powerful people in government, media, academia, and business are now convinced that what remains of Western Civilisation must be completely eradicated and the world must be "reset" under an anti-Christian system.

Although we are but a small and feeble voice crying in the wilderness, we shall by God's grace call upon you to "learn not the way of the heathen."

## DO MANNERS MATTER ANYMORE?

We have become a nation of rude people. Does that matter? I actually think it does because there is a link between manners and morals.

As a grandfather of three little children, it's so important to teach them to engage in good manners, and to be grateful. I even write thank you notes to local places we visit, such as our unique South Florida butterfly attraction or a local farm tour, and have them each write something on the thank you card.

Manners do matter, and I'll explain why in a moment.

In our documentary for Providence Forum, "The Beginning of Wisdom" — which is all about the extraordinary role the Bible played in early American education — the narrator says, "In the early 1960s (and earlier, going back to colonial times), schools opened in

prayer." (I remember that, ed.)

Then Judge Darrell White, the founder and director of Retired Judges of America, notes, "In 1962, there was a case called, Engel v. Vitale, that came out of New York Board of Regents prayer that was a very tepid prayer, asking God's blessing on ourselves, our parents, our teachers, and our country, amen, and that was struck down by the United States Supreme Court, they nullified that prayer. And in the following year devotional reading of the Bible in a case called, Abington v. Shempp, that was nullified as well."

Next on the documentary comes Dennis Prager of PragerU: "The Supreme Court changed America more with the 1962 decision that prayer in school was unconstitutional. That was the decision that began the end of America as we knew it. It's as universal a prayer and non-denominational as you could have. And as I often point out, within one generation, kids went from blessing their teachers to cursing their teachers."

Do manners matter? One of the great aspects of George Washington was his adherence to biblical-type principles in a book he studied thoroughly, The Rules of Civility.

Meanwhile, it would be fair to say that politics has virtually always had an uncivil tone. Frankly, today's politics (generally) can be viewed as relatively tame.

In 1856, anti-slavery Senator Charles Sumner of Massachusetts was nearly beaten to death by a pro-slavery Congressman from South Carolina. This took place in the U.S. Capitol.

I believe there is a link between manners and morals. William Wilberforce, the great 18th-19th century Christian statesman, who spent his lifetime championing the cause of abolishing the slave trade and slavery in the British Empire as a longtime Member of Parliament, was also engaged in a lesser-known crusade.

He and other reformers in pre-Victorian England pushed for what they called "the reformation of manners." The modern translation of that would be "the reformation of morals."

In short, manners and morals are related. But they are not the same. A person can have great manners and be morally corrupt. The Eddie Haskell character in "Leave it to Beaver" provides a classic humorous example of that

However, if you remove manners from society, we are left with a crasser and cruder world. Outward good

manners are generally a reflection of inside decency and kindness, and reflect the Christian concept of putting others ahead of self.

We know we're supposed to love our neighbor as ourselves. At just about every wedding, they read the love chapter from Paul's letter to the Corinthians. Included in that chapter is: "Love is ... not rude."

Employing basic good manners also applies the golden rule of Christ. It's treating others as we would want to be treated.

Schools today often have serious problems with discipline. At a more basic level, good manners are gone. In some cases, the schools are even unsafe.

My daughter taught English as a second language in rural Thailand for a semester several years ago. She marveled at how polite and well-behaved the students were. As she would walk into each class, a student volunteer would shout out, "Stand up, class!" They all stood up for the teacher. Then they would cheerfully say in unison, "Good morning, teacher!" They would not sit down until she let them. Needless to say, there was no need for metal detectors in those schools.

In his book, The Tipping Point, Malcolm Gladwell writes of the "Broken Windows theory," postulated by James Q. Wilson and George Kelling: "If a window is broken and left unrepaired, people walking by will conclude that no one cares and no one is in charge. Soon, more windows will be broken, and the sense of anarchy will spread from the building to the street on which it faces, sending a signal that anything goes" (p. 141).

Rudeness and boorish behavior send a signal that anything goes. Bad manners can signal a breakdown in civilized behavior. All the while, the test of good manners is to put up with bad ones.

Yes, sir, manners matter.

#### Why Character Doesn't Matter Anymore

The "cheerful prudery" of Ned Flanders has given way to vulgarity, misogyny, and partisanship. What does this mean for our witness?

I guess Ned Flanders goes to strip clubs now.

Until this week, I hadn't thought about the caricatured born-again Christian neighbor on the animated series *The Simpsons* in a long time. New York Times **religion reporter Ruth Graham** mentioned him and his "cheerful prudery" as examples—along with Billy Graham and George W. Bush—of what were once the best-known evangelical Christian figures in the country. Indeed, a 2001 Christianity Today cover story dubbed the character "Saint Flanders." Evangelical Christians knew that Ned's "gosh darn it" moral demeanor was meant to lampoon us, and that his "traditional family values" were out of step with an American culture this side of the sexual revolution.

But Ned was no Elmer Gantry. He actually aspired to the sort of personal devotion to prayer, Bible reading, moral chastity, and neighbor-love evangelicals were supposed to want, even if he did so in a treacly, ultra-suburban, middle-class North American way. As Graham points out, were he to emerge today, Flanders would face withering mockery for his moral scruples—but more likely by his white evangelical co-religionists than by his beer-swilling secular cartoon neighbors.

As Graham says, a raunchy "boobs-and-booze ethos has elbowed its way into the conservative power class, accelerated by the rise of Donald J. Trump, the declining influence of traditional religious institutions and a shifting media landscape increasingly dominated by the looser standards of online culture." (This article you are reading right now represents something of this shift, as I spent upward of 15 minutes pondering how to quote Graham's article without using the word boobs.)

Graham's analysis is important for American Christians precisely because the shift she describes is not something "out there" in the culture but is instead driv-

en specifically by the very same white evangelical subculture that once insisted that personal character—virtue, to use a now distant-sounding word the American founders knew well—matters.

Yes, part of the vulgarization of the Right is due to the Barstool Sports / Joe Rogan secularization of the base, in which Kid Rock is an avatar more than Lee Greenwood or Michael W. Smith. But much more alarmingly,

the coarsening and character-debasing is happening among politicized professing Christians. The member of Congress joking at a prayer breakfast about turning her fiancé down for sex to get there was there to talk about her faith and the importance of religious faith and values for America. The member of Congress telling a reporter to "f— off" is a self-described "Christian nationalist." We've seen "Let's Go Brandon"—a euphemism for a profanity that once would have resulted in church discipline—chanted in churches. ...

Who can deny that the one-time godly Christianity Culture no longer exists, except in a few "bright spots?" The profanation of the Christian Culture started when godly Christians sacrificed their children to the god of the age, the State, and the pulpits no longer stood against "king worship."

**Leviticus 18:21** And thou shalt not let any of thy seed pass through [the fire] to Molech, neither shalt thou profane the name of thy God: I [am] the LORD.

*Profane*: Polluted, defiled, desecrated, prostituted, violated.

Baptist theologian John Gill (1697-1771) comments on v. 21.

The word *fire* is added by the translators. (Leaving out the translators' word, *fire*, gives the passage a completely different understanding, and tells us that service to Molech, Malcolm and Baal is service to the various gods around us.) According to Aben Ezra, Moloch was a general name for everyone whom they made to reign over them; and it is right, he says, that it is the abomination of the children of Ammon, and so the same with Milcom, 1Ki 11:5; and with Baal, as appears from Jer 32:35; and they are both of much the same signification, the one signifies a king, the other a lord; and perhaps is



the same with the Melicarthus of Sanchoniatho ... Aben Ezra observes, explain the phrase, "let to pass through," of their causing them to pass from the law of God to the religion of Molech, or of devoting them to his service and worship;

neither shall thou profane the name of thy God; who had given them children, and to whom they ought to have devoted them, and in whose service they should have trained them up to the honour of his name; but instead of that profaned it, by the above idolatrous and cruel usages: I [am] the Lord; who would avenge such a profanation of his name. (John Gill)

## That is, Molech, Malcom and Baal all signify a king or a lord over a people.

To pass through means causing the Christian children to pass from under the law of God to pass under the religion of the king, humanism. They thus become devoted to the pagan religion of the State, and they see little if any problem of the profanation of those in the public eye, politicians. Moloch worship was and is king worship. Profaning the name of God is accomplished by parents passing the children out from under the law of God, and passing them under the ruler of the age to be trained up in his service, humanism.

Passing from under the *law of the Lord* to passing under the *law of man* leaves them with no firm definition of Truth from God's law. They are now easily blown about by various winds of the doctrines of men.

#### **Results:**

- 1) Starting with the Statist education system, the onetime godly Christian Culture has become so profane that Christian Character no longer matters. The name of God has been profaned.
- 2) Politicians and religious leaders cloak themselves in religious actions and words, and profane the worthy name by which we are called, James 2:7. Accordingly, they are able to mislead the Christian community for the glory of men.
- **3)** God's face is set against those who profane His name.

**Leviticus 20:3** And I will set my face against that man, and will cut him off from among his people; because he hath given of his seed unto Molech, [the king, the state] to defile my sanctuary, and to profane my holy name.

Every Christian is called to work to build a Christian Culture in his own life, in his home, in his church and in his community. Recovering the lost Christian Culture must include **2 Corinthians 7:15** 

And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel? 16 And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in [them]; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. 17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean [thing]; and I will receive you,

We must depart from the Molechs, Malcoms and Baals, the gods of this world that control our lives. We must refuse to pass our children through humanistic, man exalting laws that profane the name of the Lord our God, for pass through [the fire] aptly describes what parents do to their children. The fire of king worship, humanism, burns out the love for God and for the law of the Lord. Christian Culture is lost from the bottom up, from the inside out. The loss starts with the families who have passed their children through the fire of the State's humanism.

Hosea 4:9 And there shall be, like people, like priest: and I will punish them for their ways, and reward them their doings.



## GIVE ME SCOTLAND, ERE I DIE

A French warship drifted slowly along the coast of Scotland, ominously symbolizing the bondage of the Scottish people. It was a cold icy day, and fog hung closely around the ship so that the shoreline was barely visible through the mist.

A prisoner was on board, a thin man who was already past the prime of life. His body was worn down from many months as a galley slave. His health was broken. His back was sore, and he had recently been very sick. It had been many months since he had seen his native land. But as the fog began to lift, a few of his fellow-



prisoners lifted their companion up so that he could peer toward the shore. They asked him what he saw. The sunken eyes of the sick man looked up through the fog, squinting to make out the skyline of the coastal town of St. Andrews, with its frowning castle and massive cathedral spires, the stronghold of Roman Papal power in Scotland.

Suddenly, his eyes gleamed with life. He sat erect at his oar, trembling with hope and triumph. "Yes," said the prisoner, "I know it well. For I see the steeple of that place where God first in public opened my mouth for His glory, and I am fully persuaded, how weak that ever I now appear, that I shall not depart this life till that my tongue shall glorify His goodly name in that same place."

It seemed merely the vain and delirious hope of a dying man. At this time, Scotland was in the complete grip of a foreign power. A French woman named Mary of Guise was Queen Regent of Scotland, and she sat on the throne in behalf of the princess, Mary Stuart, who was being reared across the channel in the opulent court of France, drinking deeply of French customs,

French religion, and French morals as well. The French fleet had been called in to enforce French power, and it seemed that Scotland would never be free from darkness, tyranny, and oppression in church and state. The powerful bishops held complete sway in the land, and simony, adultery, nepotism, and various other sins were notorious among the clergy. St. Andrews was the stronghold of their power.

The few bold Reformers who had dared preach the truth, men like Patrick Hamilton and George Wishart, had been burned to death at the stake.

On that cold and foggy day, it seemed that light and truth were gone forever from Scotland. But the light of truth burned brightly in the heart of one man. If all despaired, he would not despair. Let Queen, Regent, Pope, and council rage as they will, Jesus Christ still sat on the Throne. Although he was weak, John Knox prayed with firm resolve, "Lord, give me Scotland, ere I die."

The God of heaven can work a mighty change in a brief period of time. Sometimes, our Lord changes a culture, a nation, a civilization slowly over the course of many centuries. But the God who brought Israel out of Egypt with a mighty hand and stretched out arm can still work a mighty revolution in a few short years. So it was in Scotland. In only ten years, Scotland would be changed forever.

Far away in London, a young king named Euwaiu VI took the throne of England. He had a burning zeal for God's truth. By his intervention, the galley slaves were released from French vessels.

In 1549, John Knox became a free man. God was answering Knox's prayer. All across Scotland, the hearts of noblemen, farmers, merchants, seamen, fishermen, and soldiers were being opened. English Bibles from the south found their way into homes.

In 1551, Knox was invited to London to become the chaplain for Edward VI. After Edward died, Mary Tudor took the throne and Knox was forced to flee to the continent. Again, it seemed his hopes were vain and empty.

In 1553, John Knox became pastor of an English-speaking church in Geneva. Away from loved ones, hopes, plans, and ambitions, Knox prayed on: "Lord, give me Scotland, ere I die."

In 1555, Knox secretly returned to Scotland. He sought to urge the nobles of Scotland to do their duty, and throw off the yoke of idolatry. He preached and

taught wherever he had a hearing, right under the noses of his enemies. While in Scotland, John Knox married Marjory Bowes and took his young wife to the safety of Geneva.

In 1558, trom Geneva, Knox wrote a series of three blazing letters. The first he titled "First Blast of the Trumpet Against the Monstrous Regiment of Women." In this treatise, he proclaimed that the rule of female monarchs was a judgment upon Scotland for her idolatry. At the same time, Knox also wrote his "Appellation to the Scottish Nobility," in which he pleaded with the noblemen to abhor idolatry, renounce the authority of the Pope, bow to the supremacy of the Law of God, and purge the land of oppression in church and in state. The third letter was a "Letter to the Commonalty of Scotland," urging upon fishermen, shepherds, and farmers their duty before God.

These three treatises had a remarkable effect upon the realm of Scotland. Psalm 110:3 declares, "Thy people shall he willing in the day of Thy power." The Lord always makes his people willing to act when the day of His power comes. Soon after these letters were sent, several noblemen, soon to be called "the Lords of the Congregation," wrote to Knox, asking him to return to Scotland and lead them in the work of Reform.

In 1559, John Knox returned in triumph to his native land. Only ten years before, he had been a galley slave on a French ship, peering through the fog at the Cathedral of St. Andrews. Now, he was back.

It was a dramatic showdown of power. St. Andrews was the stronghold of Papal power in Scotland. The Queen Regent hated Knox for his "Blast of the Trumpet" and for his defiance of her tyranny and idolatry. Knox had been publically burned in effigy, and he knew the enemy sought his life. Knowing of Knox's intention to come to St. Andrews, the Bishop sent a message to the Lords of the Congregation, threatening to have 100 spearmen outside the church to prevent Knox from entering that pulpit.

Knox was not a man to quail before such threats. He said, "My life is in the hands of Him whose glory I seek, and therefore I fear not their threats." The Lords of the Congregation backed Knox with their own menat-arms, and Knox entered the pulpit of St. Andrews and boldly preached against the Queen and the Bishop, asserting that Jesus Christ is supreme in church and state. To the astonishment of all, the civil magistrates of St. Andrews agreed to rid the town of all monuments of

idolatry. Altars of mass were overthrown, images were toppled, carvings were chiseled out of niches, artwork was removed from walls, candles were snuffed out, and the pulpit became the simple and central focus of public worship.

Immediately, the Queen Regent launched her troops against the Reformers. The Lords of the Congregation would not back down, but banded together to defend with the sword of civil power the Gospel that Knox preached.

In 1560, the Queen Regent died, and the young Mary Queen of Scots came to rule the realm in her own right. John Knox became pastor of the Church of St. Giles in Edinborough where he preached the truth right down the street from the palace of the new Queen.

Mary Queen of Scots was young, beautiful, and persuasive, but Knox could not be moved by tears, smiles,

threats, or false promises. During one interview, Mary Queen of Scots said that her conscience was assured that the Roman religion was correct. Knox replied respectfully but boldly, "Conscience, Madam, requireth knowledge; and I fear that right knowledge ye have none." He also told her, "If princes exceed their bounds, Madam, no doubt they may be resisted, even by power."

On another occasion, when Mary wept bitterly over Knox's rebuke or her immorality, he answered "I never delighted in the weeping of any of God's creatures, but seeing I have spoken the truth as my vocation craves of me, I must sustain your Majesty's tears rather than betray my Commonwealth through my silence."

Eventually, the young queen's bad morals and secret plots became so outrageous that Mary was deposed and convicted of treason, adultery, and idolatry.

By the time of Knox's death in 1572, Scotland was thoroughly Reformed. The pulpits were aflame with truth. The Lords of the Congregation were triumphant. Idolatry was outlawed throughout the land. The Scottish nobility had boldly united in covenant to uphold the Law of God throughout the realm.

When Knox was dying, he asked his wife to read from John 17, the passage instrumental in his conversion many years earlier, saying, "there I cast my first anchor."

One of the Scottish earls said of Knox, "There lies one who in his life never feared the face of man."

In our current crisis, we need the confident hope of

Knox. America cannot be made great by a political party or a conservative candidate. A nation will only prosper when it will unite in covenant to acknowledge Christ as King and His Word as Law.

## **E**motions

Emotions are powerful! Someone becomes so angry that they put their fist through the wall ...and, of course, sometimes suffer the consequences of a broken hand. How do you deal with such emotion in a counseling situation? A local television newscast in the Dayton area recently encouraged listeners to allow their children to "take out their frustrations by beating a pillow. It is O.K. to ventilate your anger." Such advice is not uncommon, but what does God have to say about this important issue of emotions?

The point of this article is that God's Word makes it clear that you have been created with emotions. However, Scripture is also clear that you must not live an emotional/feeling-oriented life.

Emotions are neutral. Emotions do, however, fall into two general categories -- good and bad. "I feel good," which includes happiness or "I feel bad," which includes sadness. So what are emotions and feelings? Feelings are simply responses you make to judgments about the environment in relation to one's self. Jay Adams states, "The word feeling' refers to the perception of a bodily state as pleasant or unpleasant ("I feel bad: I feel tired:

I feel happy'). These judgments trigger body chemistry to orient the body in a particular direction to meet a specific situation. This body orientation accounts for the feelings " [Christian Counselor's Manual (CCM) p. 112]

There are some problems regarding emotions, life, and counseling. One problem is that we have a feeling-oriented society. You see it all around you. An interviewer asks, "How did you *feel* about that. . .?" "What do you *feel* is the right thing to do?" In the church you hear, "I *feel* God has led me to tell you ..." "How can it be wrong if it *feels* so right?" The point in all this is that many don't want to think anymore; they just want to

sit around and emote! This feeling orientation has crept into the Church. It is evident in the music -- "Surely the Presence of the Lord is in this place. I can *feel* His mighty power,..." It is evident in the way many speak of guidance -- "I *feel* God has led me to do..." "I have a peace about ...." It is evident in many doctrinal matters -- "I feel/don't *feel* saved ...." "The Holy Spirit is the most wonderful *feeling* there is!" It is also evident in the way many do counseling. Many tend to focus on the *feelings* as the root problem when, in reality, it is only the symptom!

The "problem " of emotions is a sin problem. One may be emotional, but that's not a problem with emotions. . . the emotions are working just fine! The point here is that there are only two ways of living (Eph. 4:22-24; Gen. 3; I John 2): the feeling-oriented way of living or the commandment-oriented way of living. The problem goes clear back to Adam and Eve when they chose to live by their desires as opposed to the clear commands of God.

So, what must the Biblical counselor do in addressing emotions? First of all, realize, "All emotions of which (God) made us capable are constructive when used properly. (i.e., in accordance with biblical principles). All emotions, however, can become destructive when we fail to express them in harmony with biblical limitations and structures." (CCM pg. 349)

Realize, too, what "emotional problems" are not! They are "red lights" indicating that there is a problem, much like pain does to the physical. "Emotional problems" are really "pre-emotional" because emotions are triggered by immediate conscious thought and/or actions or by unconscious habit patterns that automatically release emotional responses. Therefore, root out the cause of the emotional response and, if there is a specific behavior or thought that is directly associated with the undesirable emotion, then deal with it concretely. For example, if a counselee says, "I *feel* guilty about my habit" - smoking, drinking, cursing, gossip, or "I *feiel* sad because I had an argument with my spouse before church," then the counselee must confess, repent, and take steps to change.

If emotional responses resulted from a well-developed sinful response pattern no longer requiring conscious thought to set it in motion, then the solution lies in discovering the pattern, dehabituating with the power of the Spirit and replacing it with a Biblical response. The solutions lie not in attacking the emotions,

but in rooting out the cause of the emotional response and then dealing with it in light of God's Word.

In conclusion, you must not live according to feelings, but rather choose to live by the principles of God's Word no matter how you feel (Eph. 4:22-24). It is your choice whether emotions fall on good or bad ground. When dealing with counseling problems ... focus on thinking and behavior versus feelings. This gives hope because you are dealing with the "heart" of the problem (Luke 6:43-45) rather than merely symptoms. Feelings reveal the heart especially during trials. God calls you to be committed to obedience ... at every turn. The problem is that many respond to this call with, "I don't feel like it." This shows that they are dominated by emotions. "I'm sorry, God, I can't obey because ... I'm angry, tired, depressed, fearful, worried ..." "Because of his high calling in Christ, the believer must live differently ...." (Jay Adams, Christian Councilor's Manual, p. 162)

### WHERE ARE THE GRANDCHILDREN?

Many of today's older Americans are missing out on a tremendous blessing

It's probably the birth of three grandaughters in the last 10 months that helped me notice. And what I noticed is there appears to be fewer grandparents than there used to be. I don't have an authoritative study to cite, but I'm coming across a lot of people my age who tell me they have no grandchildren, and a few who say that they have only one, and they don't expect any more.

These are literate, educated people. They are not necessarily liberal politically, but they do tend to say, "I raised my children to pursue their dreams." Apparently, those dreams didn't include children. They put the best face on it, highlighting the accomplishments of their children, especially the girls. But I can tell by the look in their eyes, and the tone of their voices, they're disappointed.

This is the place where I'm supposed to add the caveats about infertility, or a lack of "good men," or opioids, or even the celibacy of the Apostle Paul. But I'm boneweary of hearing those, and they strike me as anodyne. We all know what is going on in most cases. People, statistically speaking, are choosing childless lives.

When we look at the age distribution for most countries, they look more like tops beginning to wobble than the pyramids of Giza. But since most of the conse-

quences are approaching at glacial speed, we can wipe our foreheads and like Hezekiah say, "Thank goodness I won't live to see it." But it's not true. The consequences have begun to arrive.

I posted something to this effect on X (formerly Twitter), and among the responses was the predictable, "No one is owed grandchildren." As I noted before, some people I spoke with were not politically liberal, but they were liberal in another sense. They raised their children to pursue their dreams without any thought of giving their parents a heritage.

People without grandchildren can see the end of the line, a line that goes all the way back to Adam and Eve but is ending with their children because there are no grandchildren.

Notice, I didn't place the word, heritage in "scare quotes." That's because the heritage I'm speaking of is the natural line, as in the natural family. That isn't a "social construct," unlike the term, "social construct." Predictably, when something natural is deconstructed, it dies. And for many families, this is happening. People without grandchildren can see the end of the line, a line that goes all the way back to Adam and Eve but is ending with their children because there are no grandchildren. And they've been told to get over it because, "No one is owed grandchildren."

Psalm 128 ends with, "May you see your children's children!" They're a blessing you can hope for, but you can also prepare for, and one of the ways to do that is by teaching your children that it is a blessing to have children. It's a blessing that other things should be sacrificed for because little images of God are more valuable than boats, exotic vacations, or corner offices—and any other idol we make for ourselves.

But the lack of grandchildren also has a practical consequence. If we do not recover a sense of duty to God and our parents to carry on the burden of the natural family, many of the things that we assume make children unnecessary will collapse. Do you truly believe your 401K will continue to rise when the number of young people sinks? Or that Social Security will keep its promises when fewer people are paying into it than are drawing on it? The value of the stock market and the solvency of our social welfare schemes are supported by the productive energies of the young.

Without a rising generation those things will fall in value, or into insolvency. Half measures won't save them. Immigration can mitigate the effects for a time,

but sooner or later you run out of other people's children. Robots can help the supply side, but not the demand side, and wealth creation depends on both. And if you imagine we can mass produce children in the lab, can you also imagine that there would undoubtedly be negative consequences that we can't even imagine?

Grandchildren are a part of God's plan. The alternative is disaster.

The above article points out the lack of grandchildren. Scripture speaks of following generations. It seems that many in this generation have chosen to miss the blessings of children and grandchildren.

Why? Maybe because young men have not been taught the biblical requirement to marry and raise a godly family to serve the Lord. (Maybe he got snared by the beauty of the Proverbs 4 woman.) Maybe because young women have not been taught the biblical requirement to marry and raise a family. Though a lay-pastor, my dad never mentioned the Christian responsibility of marriage and raising a godly family to serve the Lord. Having fallen victim to the lies of the world and of the flesh, we have been taught that self-fulfillment with no responsibility is all important. However, throughout scripture, the lack of children was a mark of shame, *e.g.*, Genesis 16:1, 30:1, 1 Samuel 1, but now it seems to be a matter of little if any concern—As long as I can live the life pleasing to myself.

Deuteronomy 1:10 The LORD your God hath multiplied you, and, behold, ye [are] this day as the stars of heaven for multitude. 11 (The LORD God of your fathers make you a thousand times so many more as ye [are], and bless you, as he hath promised you!)

Moses tells them that **through natural means**, God miraculously multiplied their numbers as He fulfilled His promise to Abraham.

Psalms 127:3 Lo, children [are] an heritage of the LORD: [and] the fruit of the womb [is his] reward. 4 As arrows [are] in the hand of a mighty man; so [are] children of the youth. 5 Happy [is] the man that hath his quiver full of them: they shall not be ashamed, but they shall speak with the enemies in the gate.

Throughout Scripture we have been told that children

are a sign of God's blessing. Children are God's reward to his faithful people; they are blessings from God upon the family; they are gifts of God to his faithful people.

This writer must admit that he did not realize the emphasis on children until he "married" into the homeschool movement. One cannot help but see the joy, and problems, of families who welcome whatever God provides. We have also noticed that homeschool children are basically well behaved through lengthy church services.

There was a "poor man" in the church is Louisiana where I served for 7 years as an associate pasotr. He had 5 or 6 children at that time as the Lord provided. His wealth was in his children. That was in the middle 1970s. I wonder how many he had since then, and what

they are doing now.

### HOMESCHOOL EXPLOSION

## Washington Post: Explosion in Home Schooling Is Permanent

The liberal Washington Post reported yesterday on the results of a survey of some 360 school districts around the country:

[Our] analysis reveals that a dramatic rise in home schooling at the onset of the pandemic has largely sustained itself through the 2022-23 academic year, defying predictions that most families would return to schools [once Covid restrictions were lifted.]

With the number of young people being schooled at home jumping by more than 50 percent (while public-school enrollment dropped), the Post was forced to admit its "arrival as a mainstay of the American education system, with its impact ... only beginning to be felt."

According to the Post, the practice of schooling at home "embrace[s] a largely unregulated practice once confined to the ideological fringe."

The growth in real numbers is both impressive and reassuring. There is now, according to the Post, "at least one home-schooled child for every 10 in public schools ... [which signifies] a sea change" in how young children are being educated in school districts across the country.

That "sea change," according to the Post, could mean that the kids might not learn, or might be abused, the paper suggested: "There is little or no regulation of home schooling in much of the country, with no guarantees that kids are learning skills and subjects to prepare them for adulthood — or, for that matter, learning anything at all."

But the present public-school system, in districts

around the country, is already failing them. In Baltimore, for instance, according to the New York Post, "None of the students at 40% of Baltimore's public high schools tested proficient on the state's math exam ... with a staggering three-quarters [of them] earning the lowest possible score."

At Patterson High School, in Baltimore City, for example, just 12 students out of the school's 628 students enrolled there were reading at grade level.

The Post failed to mention the reason why, but according to another study done by the Post and George Mason University, the real reason is obvious. Half of all U.S. parents who homeschool do so because "local schools are influenced too much by liberal viewpoints."

Although John Dewey is often reported to have had an undue influence on American education, it was Horace Mann who is called "The Father of American Education" for inflicting the present public-school system onto the country. In 1837, he became chairman of the Massachusetts Board of Education, and from that moment on devoted his entire energy toward removing religious influence from schools. He persuaded his fellow "modernizers" to push for tax-supported elementary schools, with one of the primary principles being "that this education must be non-sectarian." The purpose, according to Mann, was to "equalize the conditions of men" by teaching them early "obedience to authority." He publicly declared that "our Public Schools are not Theological Seminaries" and made sure that books that were "calculated to favor the tenets of any particular set of Christians" were proscribed.

Once the poison of relativism, evolution, humanism, and scientism was introduced into the culture through the schools, it was just a matter of time before the Bible and prayer were "proscribed" as well.

The rise in homeschooling is good news for Americans aghast at the inroads progressivism is making into every corner of the culture. Homeschoolers typically outperform their public-school peers in every aspect of life, they are also vastly more politically active.

As Malcolm Gladwell pointed out in his ground-breaking book The Tipping Point, there is the "law of the few." He writes:

There are certain, special types of people who are much more effective at broadcasting [their] ideas and getting people to listen and to follow suit.

With one in every 10 students being schooled at home as the Post now admits, we're close to, if not at, that

perfect inflection point — the "sea change" that the Post writes about — where the tide begins to turn in the other direction

Are you a child of God? Have you repented of your sins and believed on the crucified and resurrected Lord Jesus Christ? Do you seek a life of holiness and bow to Christ's Lordship? If so, you have an adversary. He is the adversary of God and of God's people—a powerful, deceitful, dangerous, relentless, merciless adversary. Among other names and titles, he is called Satan, Lucifer, the devil, Abaddon, Apollyon, Beelzebub, the serpent, the enemy, the father of lies, the prince of this world, the prince of devils, the prince of the power of the air, the god of this world, the great red dragon, and more. This is your adversary, O child of God.

Your adversary is not a cartoon character to laugh at, nor is he a grotesque, red monster with horns, cloven feet, a tail, and a pitchfork. Rather, he masquerades as an angel of light. He is one of the greatest theologians in existence and knows the Word of God well. He can quote it, twist it, add to it, subtract from it, weaponize it, confuse its interpretation, and pervert its translation. He wants your worship. If he cannot have it, he will

seek to destroy your testimony. If he had his way—under our Sovereign God, he does not—he would eradicate God's Word from the face of the earth. If he had his way—under our Sovereign God, he does not—he would kill every believer in Christ. Since he cannot, he will vex, trouble, tempt, slander, confuse, corrupt, distract, shame, disgrace, discredit, persecute, and murder believers, when God grants him permission. Ask Job, David, Peter, Paul, or Jesus.

Listen to John: "the whole world lieth in wickedness" (1Jo 5:19). The Greek word translated wickedness can also be translated "in the wicked one." Listen to Paul: "In time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience"—and every unbeliever is a child of disobedience. Paul also said that "the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them" (2Co 4:4). Carefully consider two important things in these verses: (1) all unbelievers live under Satan's rule, and (2) the light of Christ Jesus, revealed in the gospel of God's grace, is the unbeliever's only hope for pardon of sin, eternal life, and deliverance from Satan's cruel tyranny.

For all that has just been said, dear child of God, the most important thing to know and believe is this: Jesus Christ has conquered Satan. By His death, burial, and resurrection, Jesus crushed the serpent's head. God's Word makes clear that God's judgment upon the adversary is the lake of fire, where he "shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever" (Rev 20:10). While Satan and his army of demons can still molest God's children, believers can resist and overcome him by the blood of the Lamb Jesus Christ. Clothed in the righteousness of Christ and in the whole armor of God, we can put the devil to flight by faith: "Resist the devil, and he will flee from you" (Jam 4:7). Remember: "The God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly" (Rom 16:20).

For this reason, the first issue of the FGB of this year

is Your Adversary. Arthur Pink's first article asks a question: Is the devil just a figment of our imagination? Pink answers that the Word of God gives conclusive evidence that the devil is real. Jonathan Edwards unfolds the extraordinary wisdom of God in the way He outwitted and overthrew the adversary. In his second article, Spurgeon gives us the ultimate weapon for overcoming Satan—the blood of Jesus Christ the Lamb of God. What a feast and encouragement for a beleaguered soul! And once again, Jonathan Edwards cheers and strengthens our hearts with knowledge that the days of our suffering physically and spiritually by the schemes and attacks of Satan will end with the adversary cast into the lake of fire for eternity. The last article in this issue leaves us with a warning about Satan's devious, unrelenting warfare against the unity of Christ's blood-bought people. O children of God, let us love one another as Christ loved us (Joh 15:12): let us not "bite and devour one another" (Gal 5:15), which is our adversary's work, but let us exalt Christ and defeat our adversary by keeping "the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace" (Eph 4:1-3).



## THE LEGACY OF HATRED

IS THE MISTRESS OF TYRANNY

Perhaps there needs to be some clarification here. All hatred is not the same! Some hatred is proper, and some hatred is evil. What distinguishes the two? God alone can differentiate between them, which He has done through His perfect revelation in His Word—the Bible. We know that a mark of loving the Lord is the position we take toward evil—"Ye that love the LORD, hate evil: he preserveth the souls of his saints; he delivereth them out of the hand of the wicked" (Ps. 97:10).

What do the prudent do in an evil time? "Seek good, and not evil, that ye may live: and so the LORD, the God of hosts, shall be with you, as ye have spoken. Hate the evil, and love the good, and establish judgment in the gate: it may be that the LORD God of hosts will be gracious unto the remnant of Joseph" (Amos 5:14-15).

God has established the standard of what we may call proper hatred, and that standard is to hate what He hates (Rev. 2:6). David wrote, "Do not I hate them, O LORD, that hate thee? And am not I grieved with those that rise up against thee? I hate them with perfect hatred: I count them mine enemies" (Ps. 139:21-22). Yes, this is the acceptable form of hatred. Our God hates all workers of iniquity (Ps. 5:5). This is an evidence that we love the Lord and hate evil (Ps. 97:10). The proper fear or reverence of the Lord is that we hate evil (Prov. 8:13).

The evil form of hatred was identified by the Lord Jesus, "The world cannot hate you; but me it hateth, because I testify of it, that the works thereof are evil"

(John 7:7). Jesus explained that the world will hate His offspring because the world hates Him (John 15:18-19).

Evidence that God has given a people over to a reprobate mind is that they are filled with unrighteousness, their minds are steeped in envy, murder, and among other things they hate God (Rom. 1:29 ff.). Those who hate God have an uncanny fixation with death—"all they that hate me love death" (Prov. 8:36).

Humanists, socialists, progressives, communists, and the various groups listed by initials profess to love but their love is hated. These profess to love humanity, but they hate the men they see, they hate those who represent honor, they hate the achievements of the past and desire its immediate removal. They love man as an idea but hate him as a being created in the image of God. They desire to wipe out any semblance of men that do not conform to their norm and the only thing left is rubble! [Tyranny Unmasked, 194]

Taylor also noted, "If civil enmities ... have every where attended legal partialities, the remedy is before our eyes. It is in vain to preach conciliation, if a policy, which inevitably begets division and hatred is adhered to." This nation has been observing the carnage of the savages as death and destruction has ridden forth through major cities devouring the freedom of others, destroying established law and order, robbing others of their life, liberty, and property, and establishing anarchy as their misguided utopia. Yes, tyranny is the mistress of hatred, and she is a vicious adversary. This nation has gone through the greatest expression of hatred perhaps in its national history. Former President Trump had his own ideocracies which many grew to hate, although they had no trouble accepting mediocrity from those about them. But they were willing to destroy a country to exercise their rabid form of hatred. This hatred was expressed during those four years wherein the media spawned myriads of lies,

**Psalms 16:4** Their [{c}] sorrows shall be multiplied [that] hasten [after] another [god]: [{d}] their drink of-

ferings of blood will I not offer, nor take up their names into my lips.

[{d}] He would neither by outward profession nor in heart, nor in mouth consent to their idolatries. (Geneva)

The wonderful promise to the saints that are on the earth, v. 3.

Though the heathen rage against the Lord and his Christ and they prosper greatly as they serve their various gods, the promise is that their sorrows shall be not added to, but multiplied upon them in God's good time. The ungodly hasten or run like mad men after their various gods while the Saints creep as snails after the Lord God. According to appearance, the ungodly are outrunning the Saints to control the earth and all that is in it.

The other gods are too numerous to list, but the list can be summed up: they are their own god and work to have all things subject to what they can imagine.

Psalms 115:2 Wherefore should the heathen say, Where [is] now their God? 3 But our God [is] in the heavens: he hath done whatsoever he hath pleased. 4 Their idols [are] silver and gold, the work of men's hands.

Their gods are material things, various inventions created according to their vain imaginations. As they develop their inventions by which they hope to replace the God of heaven and earth, *e.g.*, AI. However, the LORD does as He pleases in heaven, on earth, and under the earth. He is the one allowing the wicked invent gods after their own imagination as they not add to, but multiply upon themselves massive sorrows, pain and anguish as the LORD promises in v. 4.

**Psalms 106:29** Thus they provoked [him] to anger with their inventions: and the plague brake in upon them. **39** Thus were they defiled with their own works, and went a whoring with their own inventions. **Ecclesiastes 7:29** Lo, this only have I found, that God hath made man upright; but they have sought out many inventions.

**Their sorrows shall be multiplied** is God's promise to the wicked. That is, the longer God puts off His judgment against their self-made gods, inventions, the more they multiply their sorrows that shall come upon them.

"The sorrows consist, not merely in the disappointed hope, but also in the judgments which God suspends over the apostate." Isaiah 65:24.

**V. 4.** The context of v. 3 defines those of v. 4 as those seeking their salvation from the false gods of this world. While the *Church of the Firstborn* seek salvation and

victory from the LORD through obedience to His command-word, the wicked seek their salvation from their other gods which are the works of their own hands; that is, the gods of mammon, works, laws, all the things that are products of the fallen imagination. Today's gods include science, education, technology, medicine, fiat money, the sacrifice of unknown amounts of "blood, sweat and tears" and money to these gods, they are failing dramatically. Idolatry in general is defined in the First Commandment. Many are their gods, and many are *their sorrows* that shall come upon them.

**Drink offerings**... The vast amounts of time, energy and money invested in hoped-for salvation from the false gods will only result in reaping a whirlwind.

Hosea 8:7 For they have sown the wind, and they shall reap the whirlwind: it hath no stalk: the bud shall yield no meal: if so be it yield, the strangers shall swallow it up.

However, the *whirlwind* is no respecter of persons, as it takes everything in its path, for it rains on the just and on the unjust. But the just have built on the Rock of their salvation, so they have the promise of God's care in the floods that must come on the wicked.

The sacrifices made to those imaginary gods give a false sense of security to those outside of Christ; those sacrifices are less than worthless, for they result in death. The Israel of old shows us that judgement must come before salvation. (See the Book of Judges)

V. 5, the ungodly look to the works of their hands for their *inheritance*, but the Saints' portion is the Lord. The godly are to look to the works of the hands of the LORD for their *inheritance*.

**V. 5**, comes down hard on covetousness. The church, the individual must be content with what the LORD provides, for *The LORD is the portion of* the Saint's *inheritance*.

"the Lord is viewed here, therefore, according; to the entire fulness of the blessings and gifts which "belong to Him; and the declaration, The Lord is my portion and my cup; substantially the same as if he had said: What the Lord has, and gives, that alone do I seek; that is for me, and with it I am content. This meaning receives confirmation as the only correct one, from a comparison of the original passages in the Pentateuch, which the Psalmist manifestly has in view here. They are those in which the Lord is designated Levi's portion and inheritance:

Num. xviii. 20, "The Lord spake unto Aaron, Thou shalt have no inheritance in their land, neither shalt thou have

any part among them; I am thy part and thine inheritance among the children of Israel," ... (Hengstenburg)
